Subject: Observance of Vigilance Awareness Week, 2019

All the organizations have also been advised to consider activities relevant to the theme both within and outside their organization as well as for public/citizens during the Vigilance Awareness Week as below. As per practice in the preceding years following directions are also to be issued to all the departments of **NORTH DELHI MUNICIPAL CORPORATION**:-

A. Activities to be conducted within the organization:

- A1. Taking of Integrity Pledge by all employees. Employees may be encouraged to take e-pledge by visiting the web site. Those who take pledge verbally may be advised to record it through the website.
- A2. Conduct workshops/sensitization programmes for employees and other stake holders on policies/procedures of the organization and on preventive vigilance measures.
- A3. Conduct various competition such as debates, quiz etc. for the employees and their families on issues relating to anti-corruption.
- A4. Use organizational web site for dissemination of employees/customer oriented information and to make available avenues for redressal of grievances..

- A5. Bring out special issue of journals/newsletters on vigilance issues, systematic improvements and good practices adopted for wider dissemination and awareness.
