Subject: Uploading of 'Expression of Interest' on MCD website in respect of North DMC.

The Veterinary Services Department of North Delhi Municipal Corporation intends to utilize facilities (infrastructure i.e. Operation Theater, Post Operative Care facility etc in Delhi) and/or services of interested and experienced NGOs/Institutions/Consortiums recognized by Animal Welfare Board of India or Private Veterinary practitioners having their own infrastructure (Operation Theater, Post Operative Care facility etc in Delhi) with valid registration with Veterinary Council of India/Delhi Veterinary Council for doing surgical sterilization and anti-rabies immunization of stray dogs in the area under jurisdiction of North DMC by following Standard Operating Procedure(SOP) as prescribed by Animal Welfare Board of India (AWBI) under Animal Birth Control (Dogs) programme (ABC) to control the population of stray dogs. The details of SOPs set up by AWBI are available on website of AWBI i.e. www.awbi.org

The interested parties should also fulfil the following criteria:-

1. The interested parties i.e. NGOs/Institutions/Consortiums etc. recognized by AWBI in the field of Animal Birth Control programmes for stray dogs based in Delhi/National Capital Region/All India based should have infrastructure based in Delhi for sterilization of stray dogs including housing, kennel management, operation theatres/facilities with all necessary equipments & anti-rabies vaccines besides qualified veterinary doctors & other staff etc. or they should have capability to establish the aforesaid infrastructure required for sterilization of stray dogs under ABC programme in the area under Municipal jurisdiction of Delhi.
2. The private Veterinary practitioners should have their own infrastructure (Operation Theater, Post Operative Care facility etc) with valid registration with Veterinary Council of India/Delhi Veterinary Council for doing surgical sterilization and anti-rabies immunization of stray dogs in the area under jurisdiction of North DMC having experience in carrying out sterilization operations of stray dogs.
3. The interested NGOs/private Veterinary doctors/practitioners would have to follow the guidelines/principles/procedures with regard to pre-operative part, surgical protocols, post-operative care, anti-rabies vaccination, & release of stray dogs as prescribed in SOPs formulated by AWBI under ABC programme/mandate of the department, North DMC.
4. The evaluation of Expression of Interest(s) to find out the eligible parties would be done by a Technical Committee which would also visit the site of infrastructural facilities of the NGOs/private Veterinary practitioners for assessment thereof before recommending the case for approval of the competent authority.
5. The remuneration of Rs. 770/- per dog's sterilization and immunization would be given which includes components like picking up the dogs from field, sterilization, anti-rabies immunization, feeding and post operative care, wages of staff, ambulance etc and release of dogs in their habitat by the approved NGO/parties. However, the proportionate deduction of Rs. 70/- per dog in the amount would

be made if, the dogs are caught by the Municipal Staff i.e. 700/- per dog and Rs. 140/- would be deducted from the amount of 770/- per dog if the dog is picked up as well as released by the Municipal Staff i.e. Rs. 630/- per dog. The selected NGOs/Parties have to sign an MoU with the Corporation before start of the sterilization of stray dogs.

6. The selected NGOs/private veterinary practitioners would have to maintain all the records of the stray dogs from beginning to end i.e. from pick-up to their release (after sterilization & vaccination) as per prescribed proformas circulated by the authorities from time to time.
7. The selected NGOs/private veterinary practitioners would have to follow the rules/regulations/orders issued by the North DMC from time to time regarding running of ABC programme for sterilization and immunization of stray dogs.
8. The operative facilities/operation theatres alongwith post-operative care, kennels/units should be reasonably away from the human population/residential areas to avoid public disturbance. The kennels space for keeping of stray dogs should be of adequate size with proper ventilation & lighting, water arrangements. The interested parties can also see the indoor premises/kennels used for sterilization of stray dogs/post-operative care which are constructed by Animal Husbandry department, Govt. of Delhi & located in their veterinary Hospitals at Prahladpur (in North-West Delhi) on Bawana road, Tughlakabad (South-Delhi), Ghazipur (East-Delhi) & Tilangpur Kotla (West Delhi) on Nangloi-Najafgarh Road.

The interested & eligible parties may submit their expression of interest with complete details thereof and supported documents in the office of the Director (Veterinary Services)/North DMC, 17th Floor, Dr. SPM Civic Centre, New Delhi -110002 within 45 days of uploading of this Notice on MCD website, on all working days from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. or they can send the same via E-mail at ndmcc@mcd.gov.in or ddvseinf-ndmcc@mcd.gov.in within the stipulated period.
