Inviting NGOs/Animal Welfare Organisations (AWOs)/Private Veterinary Practitioners for Sterilization & Immunization of Stray Dogs in SDMC under Animal Birth Control (ABC) Programme.

The South Delhi Municipal Corporation (SDMC) invites applications from interested NGOs/Animal Welfare Organisations (AWOs)/Private Veterinary Doctors having a degree of B.V.Sc. & A.H. and registered with Delhi Veterinary Council/Veterinary Council of India for sterilization and immunization of stray dogs under Animal Birth Control (ABC) Programme at the centres being established by SDMC at Sector-29 Dwarka, Tehkhand and other centres.

The NGOs/AWOs/Private Veterinary Doctors, having their own infrastructure for sterilization & immunization of stray dogs may also submit their proposal indicating the facilities for sterilization of stray dogs. The NGOs/AWOs recognized by the Animal Welfare Board of India and registered under the Societies Act, 1860, or any other corresponding law shall be eligible to apply.

NGOs/AWOs/Private Veterinary Doctors interested to be associated with the programme for sterilization and immunization of stray dogs may send their details in hard copy to Additional Director (VS) at above mentioned address within 45 days of publication of this notice. Inviting Animal Welfare Organisations (AWOs)/Private Veterinary Practitioners for Sterilisation & Immunisation of Stray Dogs in SDMC under Animal Birth Control (ABC) Programme

1. The South Delhi Municipal Corporation (SDMC) invites applications from interested Animal Welfare Organizations (AWOs)/ Private Veterinary Doctors having a degree of B.V.Sc. & A.H. and registered with Delhi Veterinary Council/Veterinary Council of India for sterilisation & immunisation of stray dogs under Animal Birth Control (ABC) Programme at four centres being established by SDMC at Veterinary Hospitals of GNCTD at Mundela, Bijwasan, Nagli and Masoodpur. The AWOs recognised by the Animal Welfare Board of India and registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860, or any other corresponding law, shall be eligible to apply.
2. The AWOs/ Private Veterinary Doctors should have adequate staff (technical & non technical) and preferably vehicles as well for picking up and releasing of sterilised dogs back to the same area from where they had been picked up.
3. All interested AWOs/Private Veterinary Doctors shall have to undertake the work of sterilisation and immunisation of stray dogs as per the Animal Birth Control (Dogs) Rules 2001 and Standard Operating Procedures for sterilisation and Immunisation of stray dogs issued by the Animal Welfare Board of India (AWBI), a statutory body of Ministry of Environment & Forests Govt. Of India. All Interested AWOs/ Private Individuals/Private Veterinary Doctors are requested to go through the above rules and SOP which are available at the website of AWBI.
4. All would have to abide by the rules & regulations of the Corporation, Animal Welfare Board of India and Govt. Of India, Issued/amended time to time regarding Animal Birth Control Programme.
5. The area would cover all four zones of SDMC i.e. South, Central, West and Najafgarh Zones. However, the area/zone from where the stray dogs would be picked up for sterilisation and immunisation shall be allocated by the Corporation and would be binding on the applicant.
6. The SDMC shall fix monthly target for sterilization and immunization of stray dogs which is to be met by the applicant.
7. The AWOs/ Private Veterinary Doctors shall have to preserve the genital organs of the stray dogs sterilised by them till their verification and counting by the joint inspection team.

8. The payment of the cost of sterilisation of stray dogs shall be reimbursed as per rates approved by the Corporation from time to time after verification and counting of genital organs of dogs sterilised, by a Joint Inspection Team. Existing cost of sterilization of stray dog and immunization against rabies is Rs 770/- per dog picked up, sterilized and released back by the AWO and Rs 700/- per dog picked up the SDMC, sterilized and released back by the AWO.
9. AWOs/Private Veterinary Doctors interested to be associated with the programme for sterilisation and immunisation of stray dogs may send their application with all required details in hard copy to the Addl. Director (VS), Department of Veterinary Services, South Delhi Municipal Corporation, 17th Floor, Dr. S P M Civic Centre, Jawahar Lal Nehru Marg, New Delhi 1100002 as per the enclosed Proforma which may be collected in person from the office of the Addl. Director(VS) or may be downloaded from the website www.mcdonline.gov.in
10. The last date for submission of application is 4th July, 2017.
11. The interested AWOs/Private Veterinary Doctors may also submit the additional information relevant to the work in addition to the information sought in Proforma.
12. Each applicant would submit its willingness for each of four centres in order of preference as per enclosed proforma. However, the decision of SDMC for allocation of centre shall be final and binding on the applicant.
13. No applicant shall be allowed to withdraw from the work before a period of one year w.e.f the date of issuance of letter to work by SDMC. If anyone wants to withdraw from the work he would have to give three months prior notice to the Addl. Director (VS) failing which action shall be taken by the SDMC including debarring the applicant from the work of sterilization in future.
14. If SDMC is not satisfied with the work of sterilization, the Corporation may ask the applicant to stop the work by giving him a 3 months notice.
15. The SDMC may withdraw this public notice at any time without assigning any reason thereof.
