2	2.22 (RFP) Vol-I	<b>Revised clause 2.22 is as under:-</b> Concessionaire shall be eligible to receive Rs. 15,000 (Rupee Fifteen thousand) per event as per plan of action laid down by IEC Consultant and approved by SDMC. Such charges are subject to revision with increase or decrease in Wholesale Price Index (all commodities). Price adjustment for event charges shall be paid in accordance with the following formula: $V_m = RIX (MI - M_0) / M_0$ $R_e =$ total event charges. $V_m =$ increase or decrease in the event charges during the month under consideration due to changes in WPI (all commodities). $M_0 =$ the all India average wholesale price Index (all commodities) on the date of submission of Bids, as published by Ministry of Industrial Development, Government of India, New Delhi. $MI =$ the all India average wholesale price Index (all commodities) on the last day of the period to which a particular Interim payment certificate is related, as published by Ministry of Industrial Development, Government of India, New Delhi.

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9	2.1.17 (RFP) Vol.-I	<p>"The firm(s) / contractor already working in any of two zones of South Delhi Municipal Corporation for collection and transportation of Municipal Solid Waste shall not be eligible for participation in this tender. This shall be also applicable to the associates firms (The term "associates" already defined in clause 2.1.15 of RFP document) of the existing contractor / firm already working in any of two zones of SDMC. However, the firms working in any one zone of SDMC or in any zone / zones of other Corporations or in New Delhi Municipal Council are eligible to bid as per terms of this RFP.</p>																														
10	2.1(n) PIM Vol.-II	<p>The MSW collected during primary collection by rickshaws, three wheelers and auto tippers can be transferred to nearest MTS or FCTS for secondary transportation.</p>																														
11	3.3 (c) para 2 PIM Vol.-II	<p>Concessionaire shall be paid a Rs. 15,000/- per event for organizing events such as RWA meetings/workshops/sabra and plays etc. as per the plan of CSP to meet expenses on arranging chairs/tents/ refreshments/invitations etc., irrespective of the size of audience or number of attendees. Number of events shall be based on the plan provided by CSP.</p>																														
12	Clause 2.1.23 (RFP) Vol-I	<p>A Bidder is required to deposit, along with its Bid, a refundable Bid Security as mentioned in Data Sheet (The "Bid Security"), refundable not later than from the validity of the same from the Bid Due Date except in the case of the preferred Bidder. The Bidders will have to provide Bid Security of Rs. 25 lacs (Rs. Twenty Five lacs only) in the form of a bank guarantee drawn from an Indian Scheduled or Nationalized Bank in the form of Demand Draft or Fixed Deposit Receipt in favor of Commissioner, SDMC. The validity period of the bank guarantee as the case may be, shall not be less than number of days as stipulated in the Data Sheet from the Bid Due Date and may be extended as may be mutually agreed between the SDMC and the Bidder from time to time.
