1	3.3(ii)	Is satisfactory performance mandatory or poor performance will also qualify?	Satisfactory performance is mandatory.
2	2.1.15	The definition of Associate defined by SDMC is in violation of definition of Associate as per Companies Act. Refer: http://www.mca.gov.in/SearchableActs/Section2.htm . We request you to modify the definition in compliance with laws.	Definition of associates for this project shall be as per clause 2.1.15 of RFP document.
3	3.3(vi)	Would revaluation reserves be permitted in case of partnership or individual firm?	No change.
4	2.20.1	We request you to give a higher percentage to Diesel for Najafgarh zone. As per distance to disposal site and traffic conditions, it should be 30%.	No change.
5	2.22	These event charges will become too less due to inflation in 5-6 years. As such these should also increase with WPI/inflation.	The clause 2.22 has been amended. Please refer Addendum No. II.
6	3.3(ii)	Is satisfactory work performance certificate required or bad performance certificate will also work? Also, can the certificate be one year old?	Satisfactory performance is mandatory. For completed projects, the certificate should be issued after the completion of the project and for ongoing projects, latest performance certificate is required.
7	3.3(vii)	Please provide Net Worth formula.	Please refer clauses 3.3 (vi) of RFP document.

11		Currently, ESI, PF, Bonus, Leave Encashment, Double Wage for working on Gazette Holidays is applicable on wages. However, this changes from time to time. Department of labour and CPWD recommends that these labor levies should always be reimbursed as per actuals. CPWD also has clause 19L for this purpose. We request you to consider the same as any change would lead to a legal dispute.	The bidders are advised to make their own estimates of costs after a careful assessment of the site and all the prevailing and expected conditions including the mandatory provisions of ESI, PF, Bonus, Leave Encashment etc. as per the Labour Law and other statutory provisions that may affect the Bid. SDMC will not reimburse the labour levies to the concessionaire and the concessionaire shall be responsible for taking care of labour law.
12	Table 19	It is mentioned that two helpers at MTS shall be responsible for cleaning but in calculation only one driver and one helper have been considered. Please clarify whether MTS should have one helper or two?	Table 19 has been amended. Please refer Addendum No. II.
13	Table 27	Department has asked for 25 FCTS for Najafgarh zone where MSW generation is lowest amongst all zones. It should not be more than 15 as 25 FCTS will increase the project cost.	No change.
14		The Waste generation data i.e. 577 MT includes mixed waste/silt also because currently SDMC is using tippers for waste transportation?	Please refer table 12 of PIM for detail of projected waste generation in Najafgarh Zone. Further, bidders are advised to submit their bid in accordance to clause 2.1.3, 2.4.1 and also refer clause 18 & 19 of "Letter comprising the Bid" i.e. Appendix-I before submitting the bid.
15	Tables	SDMC has considered only 14% extra manpower. However, to cover weekly rest, 1/6 th extra manpower is required i.e. 16.66% and another 14-15% is required to compensate CL and EL. Please clarify	No change.
16	4.12	If CNG is installed in SUVs, then it is reduced from 7 seater to 5 seater. Kindly confirm whether SUV is required or Tempo Travellers?	No change.
17	Table 92	If Auto Tipper does not come at all, penalty for all 1 – a,b,c will be imposed or only one will be imposed?	Only one penalty shall be imposed as per the deficient service out of 1-a, b, c.
18	Table 92	We request you to allow tarpaulin cover for auto tippers as metal covers are not practically feasible	No change.
