1.	Introduction Vol I Page. 17	Whether during the contract period any more entry points are expected to be increased from existing 124 entry points?	As per terms of RFP, the preferred bidder can increase toll entry point, if needed, with the prior permission of competent authority.
2.	Vol. 1 Clause 12.0 Page. 25	Is there any particular format of entry ticket bearing the name & address of the firm in order to comply with the order of Supreme Court as per W.P. no. 13029/85? Whether the said order is currently followed in the existing contract or not? Please further clarify whether the average traffic data incorporated in the tender is excluding such type of vehicles or not?	Please refer to clause 12.0 Section 2-C of volume-I of RFP document at page 25 and 8.1 (e) of Vol.-III (P-22). Regarding second part of the question, it is informed that the orders of Apex Court are to be mandatorily followed.

Vol. I Clause 1.1.4 Page. 26	With regard to the issuance of Performance certificate We suggest that a Performance Certificate shall be issued by the gazette officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer or equivalent rank of any government organization or semi government body.	To be provided as per the terms of RFP Volume-I.
4.	Vol. I Clause 6.0 Page. 31	As per tender condition, the EMD prescribed is of Rs. 27 crores i.e. Rs. 10 crores as Demand Draft and Rs. 17 crore in the form of Bank Guarantee. The EMD demanded is on higher side, we hereby request you to modify the clause and accept EMD of BG which is 17 Cr and drop 10 crore which is been demanded as D.D.	EMD as per RFP.
5.	Vol.-I Clause. 10.1.2 Page-42	The Corporation has asked in RFP for up-gradation / modification of the toll plazas. Kindly clarify whether any specific designs and drawings will be issued by the MCD? If yes, kindly provide us the details of the same so as to ascertain the Financial implication of the same.	As per Clause 3.2.2 & 3.2.3 of RFP document Volume-II toll plaza design shall be as per NHAI Standard (page 10 – 14). The design and drawings are given in Appendix-IV of RFP Volume-II page 212 to 216.
